



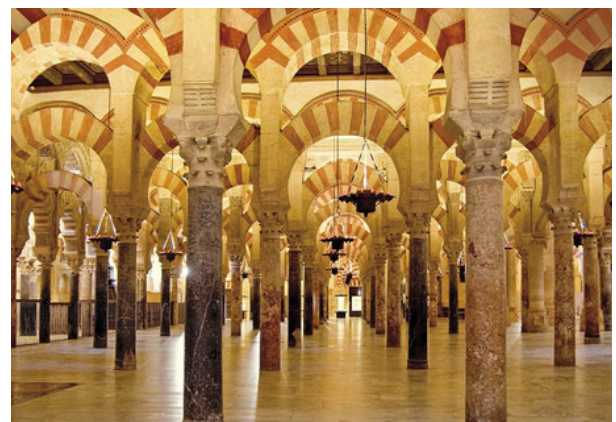
LET'S LEARN ABOUT SPAIN
